Performance Tapes

The tapes used in incontinence briefs have a more important function than you would initially think.

Use of tapes and adhesives on sensitive and elderly skin needs to be avoided as much as possible. Attaching adhesive tapes and subsequently removing them can lead to multiple skin tears, an issue commonly referred to as medical adhesive-related skin injury (MARSI).
